

Defense Systems Data Warehouse Requirement – Solicitation Number TBD. Solicitation/RFI documents for this effort not yet posted on FBO.

This requirement is for the relocation, cataloging, storage, and digitizing/transmittal "on demand" of government hardcopy/paper scientific and technical information (primarily reports). The anticipated procurement will be conducted through full and open competition as a firm fixed price contract (decision on contract vehicle, set-aside, etc. TBD). Anticipated period of performance is a 12 month base period and two, twelve month option periods.

The hardcopy scientific and technical information is currently housed at three locations operated by five incumbent contractors on behalf of the Government: Rome NY, Columbia MD and Wright - Patterson AFB, Dayton OH. The contractor for this effort ("contractor") will coordinate with the five incumbent contractors and inventory, pack, transport, unpack, catalog and shelve the materials at a secure contractor-provided storage facility which can be located anywhere in the United States. The contractor will develop and host a web-based catalog of the materials, building upon imported government-furnished electronic metadata. The contractor will retrieve, scan/digitize and transmit reports "on demand" to a secondary IAC contractor when requested. The contractor's warehouse facility must be authorized for storage of classified materials at the Secret level and personnel handling or able to access classified documents require secret clearances. SIPRnet access is not required.

The quantity of hardcopy documents is approximately 472,000, of this 50,000 are classified at the Secret level. In addition, there are 78,000 documents on microfiche and 4,000 of this is Secret. All documents and microfiche combined, require approximately 29,000 cubic feet of storage space.

Digital conversion and transmittal of reports will be required for approximately 10 months during the base year. During the option years, if exercised, the contractor will continue to fulfill document requests from the secondary IAC contractor 12 months per year. Anticipated demand is 50 documents per month.
